- All students should understand the full range of learning opportunities that are available to them. This includes academic and vocational routes and learning in schools, colleges, universities and the workplace.



What good looks like ...

- By the age of 16, every pupil should have had a meaningful encounter with a provider of the full range of learning opportunities.



What good looks like ...

- By the age of 18, all students who are considering applying for university should have had at least two visits to universities to meet staff and students.



Annual Reviews

- Opportunities discussed in Annual Reviews and follow-up conversations with young people/parents/carers.



At St Giles we:

Support with transition for post 16 / 19

- Learners are provided support with transition throughout the process
- New school settings send representatives to meet Learners prior to transition visit/s
- Transition visits are arranged for Learner and TA to visit new setting
- Parents are encouraged to participate in transition visits too.
- Support for Learners and families is ongoing into the Autumn term when Transition Support worker contacts families for feedback on new setting
