# What good looks like ...

- Every student should have opportunities for guidance interviews with a *Careers Adviser*, who could be internal (a member of school staff) or external, provided they are trained to an appropriate level. These should be available whenever significant study or career choices are being made. They should be expected for all pupils but should be timed to meet their individual needs.



# What good looks like ...

- Every student should have at least one such interview by the age of 16, and the opportunity for a further interview by the age of 18.



# Annual Reviews

- Opportunities discussed in Annual Reviews and follow-up conversations with young people/parents/carers.



# At St Giles we use : The Scope Careers Pathways Programme

- Information Advice and Guidance: The Scope Careers Pathways Programme which offers up to three one hour sessions for LDD young people aged 16 year to 19 years.
- Summer 2023 - Virtual Meetings for Yr 10 & Yr 11 Formal pathway Learners.
- Academic Year 2023- 24 - Face to Face sessions will take place





# At St Giles we :

- Support with transition for post 16 / 19
- Learners are provided support with transition throughout the process
- New school settings send representatives to meet Learners prior to transition visit/s
- Transition visits are arranged for Learner and TA to visit new setting
- Parents are encouraged to participate in transition visits too.
- Support for Learners and families is ongoing into the Autumn term when Transition Support worker contacts families for feedback on new setting
